Goal

- Web 2.0 extension to the central HRM knowledge base for function titles, skills sets,...with the goal to serve the recruitment process in a better way.
- To be used :
 - To unify the usage of skill sets, function titles, etc
 - To allow users to exchange information between communities, portals, ...
 - To allow users to test their information with commonly used descriptions.



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Collaboration in a Web 2.0 environment

- Adding content by users
- Dynamically add content based on real-time user suggestions
- Validate content by selected users
- Content brokering



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Structure

- Closed community consisting of :
 - HRM experts for contribution and validation
 - Domain experts for validation
 - System suppliers willing to incorporate the interaction mechanism.
- Access to the information for members initially



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Status

- Foundation (including content) was created by Actonomy. Now Web 2.0 extension.
- Launch of the service as a joint initiative, resulting in an existing community of several thousands of potential participants.
- Creation of community + go-life Q3 2008
